## GUIDELINES FOR FILMING IN WYCHWOOD PARK

## The Trustees of Wychwood Park

- 1. These guidelines pertain only to filming in private homes in Wychwood Park. Filming of any kind on or of common land is the responsibility of the Trustees and if requested, will be decided on a case-by-case basis using Toronto Historical Board guidelines as reference.
- 2. The homeowner shall notify the Trustees 7 days in advance of the scheduled filming.
- 3. The production company shall appoint one person to inform the Trustees of the following details: (a) the scope of the filming; (b) the length of the filming; (c) size of the crew involved in the filming; (d) number and type of vehicles required; (e) plan for parking and placement of vehicles; (f) use of Park roads; (g) insurance coverage.
- 4. Filming should have minimum impact on residents. In particular, all activity must begin no earlier than 8 a.m. and end no later than 11 p.m.
- 5. The production company shall ensure that concerns of the Trustees are dealt with and that road access and parking of vehicles is planned in the most unobtrusive way for the convenience of residents.
- 6. The production company shall notify nearby neighbours of the dates and times of the filming.
- 7. Any arrangements between the homeowner or homeowners and the production company are private.
- 8. The Trustees require a fee of \$1,000.00 per day from the production company for use of Park roads, and time spent. This fee shall go into the general funds for the maintenance of Wychwood Park.
- 9. The Trustees retain the right to refuse permission for the use of Park roads should their concerns not be satisfied.
